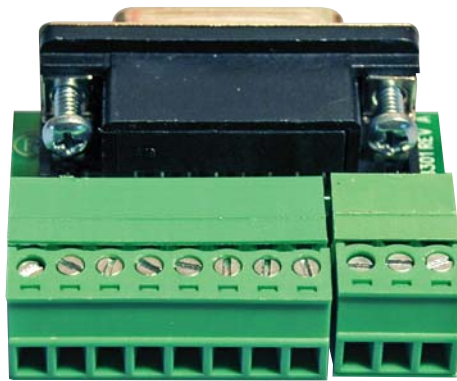

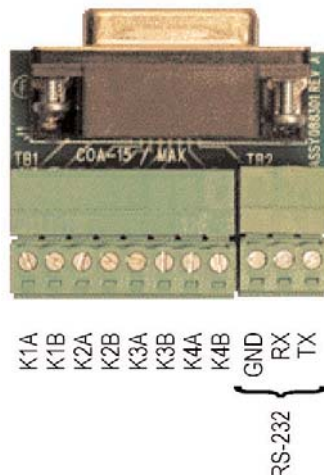

Product Description

Here's another problem solver from Broadcast Tools for the WW1, IDC MAX satellite receiver! The COA-15 MAX provides an effective way to convert the DB-15 D-Sub connector to removable screw terminals. The COA-15 MAX is designed to plug into the male 15-pin D-Sub connector on the WW1, IDC MAX satellite receiver. The COA-15 MAX is equipped with an eight-position removable screw terminal for connection to the 4 normally open dry relay contacts and a three-position connector for access to the RS-232 port. Mounting screws are provided to secure the COA-15 MAX to the receiver's DB-15, D-Sub connector.

Installation Guidelines

- Step 1: Plug the COA-15 MAX into the desired "Relay CHx" (x = channel 1 thru 4) connector on the rear panel of the WW1, IDC MAX receiver.
- Step 2: Install the two 4-40 screws (supplied) into the COA-15 MAX 15-pin male D-sub connector's mounting ears, securing the COA-15 MAX to the receiver's mating connector.
- Step 3: To wire the plug, follow the pin-out supplied on the bottom of the COA-15 MAX's printed circuit board or follow the example below. Then remove the appropriate plug from the header; remove about 1/8" of insulation from each wire. Insert the wire into the desired terminal and then tighten the screw. Be sure no bare wires are exposed.
- Step 4: Reinstall the removable screw terminal plug into the appropriate connector.

DESCRIPTION

LIMITED WARRANTY
